Institute's Profile

To achieve its mandate, the Institute conducts 2 years full time MBA programme (affiliated to BPUT and recognized by AICTE), Six months Higher Diploma in Co-operative Management. This apart, this Institute organizes an umpteen number of tailor made short term Management Development Programmes for the Cooperative and Allied Departments of Govt. of Odisha as well as other Cooperative organizations. This Institute is also accredited to C-PEC of Bankers Institute of Rural Development, (NABARD), Lucknow for undertaking capacity building programmes for Cooperative Credit and Banking Institutions.

MICM is located in the heart of Bhubaneswar (near CRP Square), having its own sprawling campus of 3.4 acres which includes administrative block, class rooms, staff quarters and hostel.

Library

MICM Library has an excellent collection of more than 17,000 books on subjects like cooperation, management, agriculture and other related areas. It also subscribes about 86 numbers of reputed periodicals and journals – both national and international.

IT infrastructure
